- Demonstrated a willingness to share/promote/teach others, AND, demonstrated a willingness to learn from others at a broader professional level (Team Player)
- Demonstrated willingness to support and participate in their respective Association's events

RULES

- Entries are open from 1 June 2025 through to 22 August 2025
- Only one (1) entry per applicant
- Entries will only be accepted from OACFP and ACCA members respectively
- The winners will be chosen by each Association's board based on the criteria above
- The decision of the judging panel will be final
- All entries must be signed by senior manager, supervisor or owner to be accepted
